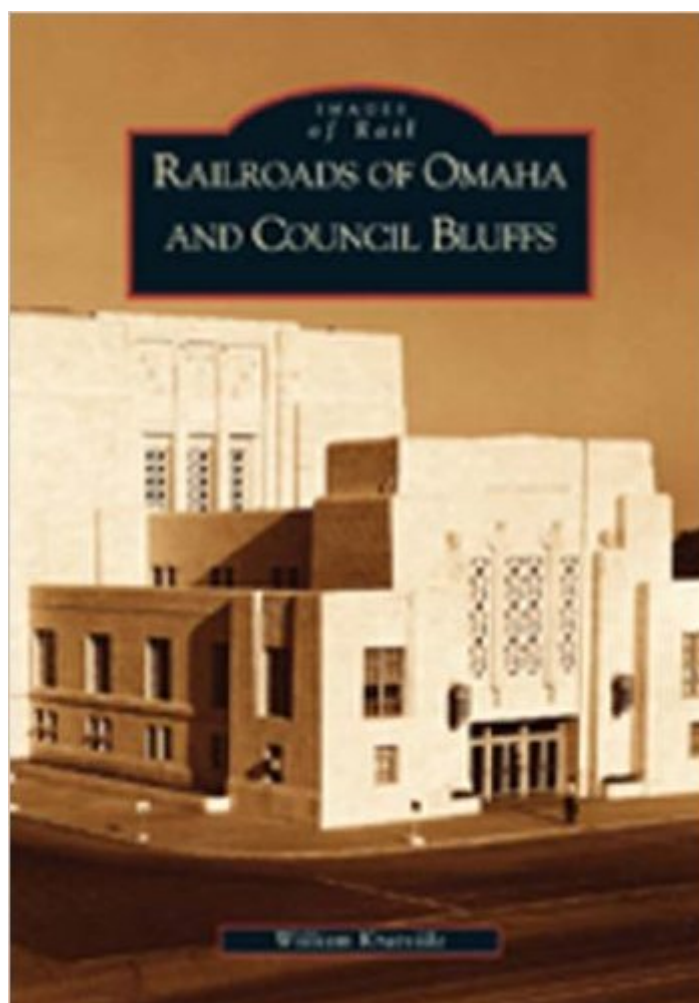

Don't expect any maps, or anything comprehensive here - this is simply a pictorial with some fascinating captioned photos from Omaha's (and Council Bluffs') prominent railroad history. The coverage is straightforward - a mini-chapter is devoted to each major line (e.g., UP, BN, etc.). My only complaint would be that the locomotive close-up photos begin to feel redundant after awhile - it's almost as if you're reading a rail car encyclopedia. However, many excellent period photos and photos of rails in the cityscape/countryside are present to make it an enjoyable flip-through.
