This Book is a lousy lousy book. I will tell you why. Save your money don't buy this book. There are much better books available.1) There are far too many typos throughout the book (misspelled words, missing letters,...). This would have been an easy fix with a spell checker;2) The book does not explain Scrum correctly nor does it use the correct terminology in a few places. As an example the author uses the term "project backlog". There isn't a project backlog, there is a Product Backlog and a Sprint Backlog.3) Scrum isn't correctly explained and reading this book would send you in the wrong direction.4) There aren't any diagrams that map out that map out the Scrum Framework nor show what the important artifacts are;I don't write negative reviews but this book was so bad that I had to.

At first, I didn't know what Scrum is, but thought of downloading it anyway. So when I first read it, I was totally confused. But then as I read more of the e-book, I was able to understand it further. The way it was written was something that the general reader can understand. However, I just noticed a few spelling errors but it is quite bearable. Don't take my word for it because I am just being me. The quality of the whole e-book is not compromised by it. Overall the entire reading was worthwhile and I have learned so much about Agile management. Worth downloading!
