

Length: 2-1/2 hours. Let me state right away, I am crazy for radio theater. I especially love westerns - Gunsmoke and Jimmy Stewart's Six Shooter are two of the greatest classics ever produced. But Colonial Radio Theater's Powder River beats both classics hands down. The story lines, combined with great sound effects and unbelievably perfect music that sets the stage for a great cast of voice actors. The weakest episode of PW is head and shoulders above the classics mentioned above. In Season 9, Volume 1, a bad hombre has kidnapped three kids and high-tailed it for Mexico. Britt, with the sherriff, Doc and Deputy Cheyenne assisting, are in hot pursuit through New Mexico. This season not only does not disappoint, it exceeds in terms of writing and acting, all previous

seasons. I've got to tell you, it was nearly impossible to post this review without including a spoiler or two. Suffice it to say, new members of the audience will want to go back and buy the earlier seasons. Long-time fans will love the surprises in this season. Before you ask, Season 9 Volume 2 also is available and is also great. Volume 1, though, remains my favorite Powder River volume. This is a 10 Star Production with a Marshall who wears the Tin Star with pride.

I've given it a 5 because I already know it will be good. Just waiting on the entire season on CD. Brilliance audio needs to produce these in a more timely fashion.

This first part of Season 9 has lived up to the standards of Colonial Radio and Jerry Robbins. They did an outstanding job. Made me feel like I was riding right there along side of Britt as I listened to it. Great job. Can't wait for part 2 to come out.
